



Feed The Children Quick Statistics

In FY 2005:

- Feed The Children distributed more than 183 million pounds of food and other essentials were delivered to all 50 states and to 65 foreign countries
 - **Domestic**
 - 132 million pounds of food
 - 19 million pounds of other essentials
 - **International**
 - 31 million pounds of food and other essentials
- Exact weight of all items distributed in FY 2005 was 183,015,941 pounds.
- Food made up 86-percent of all pounds distributed.
- 1,463,065 meals were supplemented everyday, worldwide
- Feed The Children's expenses for the year breakdown in the following way:
 - 89% for program services (*includes Food, Clothing, Education, Medical, Disaster Relief, Development, Child Care and Education*);
 - 8% for fundraising;
 - 3% for management, general and other operating costs;
- Since 1979, Feed The Children has provided assistance to people in 118 countries.

- Charity Navigator, the nation's largest charity evaluator, gives Feed The Children four stars, the highest possible rating for efficiency (www.charitynavigator.org).

- Feed The Children is the 3rd largest relief charity in the United States based on private, non-governmental support, according to the *Chronicle of Philanthropy*.
